Any enrollment acceptance is conditional upon receipt of a complete and accurate Health History and Examination Form (a separate form you will receive with your enrollment confirmation letter).

Children attending Farm & Wilderness Overnight Camps must be able to:

- Move daily on foot on uneven, outdoor terrain and negotiate natural obstacles, such as hills, streams, and boulders.
- Live in a rustic location not always accessible by power-driven vehicles.
- Sleep in a cabin or canvas structure with campers and counselors.
- Lift and carry a backpack for hiking and wilderness trips.
- Eat provided meals and drink regularly.
- Follow directions and participate willingly in camp activities, daily chores and community living activities.
- Refrain from violence, hitting, verbal assault, bullying, or any similar behavior.
- Listen well, show respect for others, work/live/play/interact in large and small groups without constant one-on-one assistance.
- Continue taking prescribed medication if directed by their doctor or parent.
- Participate in normal activities related to self-care, health and hygiene including not wetting the bed.
- Abide by F&W camp rules as explained by camp staff.
- Promptly notify F&W Staff of any health condition that requires medical attention or change of activity.

## Overnight Camps Tuition and Refund Policies

The \$500 registration fee is nonrefundable, unless you are applying for campership (financial aid). In that case, the fee is reduced to \$250 and is fully refundable before March 1st. Call the office to request a campership application or download the application from the website. Tuition must be paid in full by February 28th, 2012. Full tuition for applicants who enroll later than February 28th must accompany the enrollment application. Failure to meet payment deadline can result in cancellation of enrollment.

If the registration form for a prospective camper is withdrawn prior to March 1st, 2012, all tuition payments will be refunded, less the \$500 registration fee. After March 1st, Farm & Wilderness expects families to be responsible for the full tuition. It is not possible to make any tuition reduction for arriving late or leaving early, except for withdrawal on account of illness incurred at Farm & Wilderness. In that case, a partial tuition credit may be applied for the following year. There will be no refund if a camper is asked to leave during the season for an infraction of a camp rule or for disruptive behavior or if a child is voluntarily withdrawn.

Unpaid balances for any and all family members must be reconciled in order for a child to be enrolled.

All the information in this registration form is confidential and will be shared only with the appropriate staff at the camps and the main office. It is essential that Farm & Wilderness be made aware of any physical, mental, or emotional condition that would affect the safety of the applicant, other campers, or the staff, and of any reasonable modification necessary to ensure such safety. I understand that if I have failed to make a complete, and accurate disclosure, and if my child's undisclosed physical, mental or emotional condition adversely affects the safety of my child, other campers, or the staff of F&W, my child may be asked to leave camp and I will receive no refund of tuition.

I acknowledge that the information provided on this camper registration form and later on the Health History and Examination Form is complete and accurate. By signing this agreement, I am confirming that my child is capable of meeting the participation requirements outlined in this registration form.

I understand that camp takes place in rocky, mountainous and forested terrain and that water activities are a part of the experience. The following, potentially hazardous activities, as well as others not mentioned, may be undertaken: rustic living, hiking, swimming, canoeing, rock climbing, cooking, fire building, use of tools, farming, riding in motor vehicles and doing barn chores.

Recognizing the potential hazards outlined above, I, on behalf of myself, my child and my assigns, do hereby release Farm & Wilderness Foundation, its employees, agents, successors, and assigns, of and from any and all liability, causes of action, claims, and demands of every kind and nature whatsoever arising out of my child's participation in any F&W camp, including but not limited to any claim arising out of the conditions of the premises, the operations of the camp, the acts or omissions of F&W employees and agents, or any other negligence. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless F&W, and its employees and agents, for and from any damages, including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs, incurred in connection with my child's participation in camp.
